About Day Services

We provide meaningful day support for adults with learning difficulties and disabilities in the local community.

Based in Sibley, Homefield Day Service operates Monday - Friday, 10am - 3pm for 50 weeks of the year (excluding Bank Holidays). We also hold special events in evenings and weekends throughout the year.

Our programme is individually tailored to suit the needs, interests and aspirations of our Day Service members. We work with our members to offer a series of activities throughout the week for both small groups and individualised plans. These support activities are designed to be funded either directly through social services or with a personalised budget.

Making the most of our connections with the College, the local community and Homefield's enterprises, our activities are planned and organised to enable our members to develop skills for the future. We pride ourselves in providing support in a safe, friendly and confidential environment where our Day Service members are encouraged to attain a full and active involvement within the community.

We take new members aged 16+ and you can attend from as little as one day per week. Costing varies per person so that we can accurately provide for your unique needs.
